- Ensure that developments where we seek planning permission develop and implement a strategic approach to delivering real net gains for biodiversity.
- Ensure all our operating Divisions follow our guidance contained in our Group Standards and guidance.
- Work with and support organisations that specialise in ecology to help further our approach to adapting, managing and enhancing natural capital.
- Enhance awareness amongst our employees, customers and other stakeholders (e.g. landowners, local authorities, consultants and contractors) as to how our developments are designed and the benefits for people and biodiversity.
